
Seven Catalonian camping sites among the top in Europe, according to German users

Vilanova Park, Playa Montroig Camping Resort, El Templo del Sol, Park Playa Barà, Cambrils Park, Sangulí and Las Dunas camping sites were awarded DCC and ADAC prizes during the CBR Fair held in Munich this week, specialising in the world of caravanning

Friday, 24 February 2006— Seven Catalonian camping sites were awarded prizes this week during the celebration of the CBR Munich Fair. The DCC (Deutsche Camping Club), that awards prizes to the top European camping sites every year, chose Vilanova Park, in Vilanova i La Geltrú, as the best in Spain. This distinction holds a special value, as those deciding the best camping sites in Germany, Austria, Slovenia, Italy, Denmark and Spain are users themselves.

For its part, ADAC (German Automobile Club) distinguished seven camping sites from the Spanish state – six of them in Catalonia – in the “ADAC Camping Caravanning Führer 2006” guide. ADAC has 15 million members and their publications enjoy very wide dissemination and prestige.

The following are the camping sites distinguished by ADAC in 2006: El Templo del Sol, in L’Hospitalet de l’Infant; Playa Montroig, in Mont-roig del Camp; Park Playa Barà, in Roda de Barà; Cambrils Park and Sangulí, in Salou; and Las Dunas, in Sant Pere Pescador.

Catalonia is an important camping site destination in the south of Europe and especially in Spain, as proven by the fact that out of the eight award-winning camping sites this week in Germany, seven are located in Catalonia. The facilities and services in those camping sites are outstanding. The Catalonian camping site offer includes 354 establishments and a room capacity for more than 240,000 places.
