Dalí considered *Luminous Procuress* 'a work of genius'. Featuring members of San Francisco performance troupe The Cockettes, the film was directed by the artist and filmmaker Steven Arnold, a muse and model of Dalí's. Dalí always referred to Arnold as his 'prince', and allegedly co-produced (or at least partly funded) the film]. *The Village Voice* called the film 'a tour de force of the imagination – a journeythrough peekboxes of naked tableaux, theatres of mechanical dreams, feasts of monsters and piles of humanity.'
